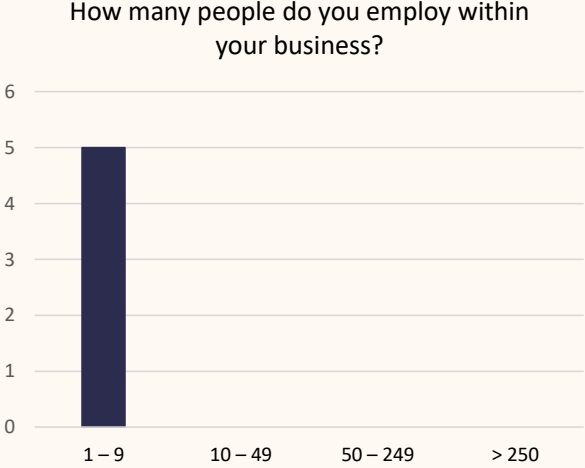
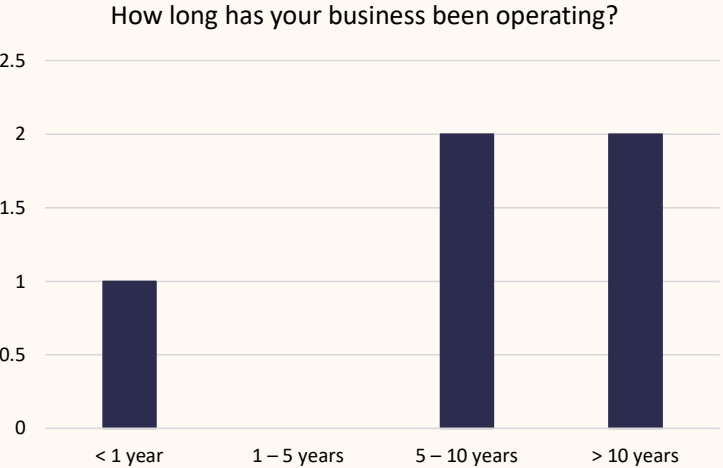

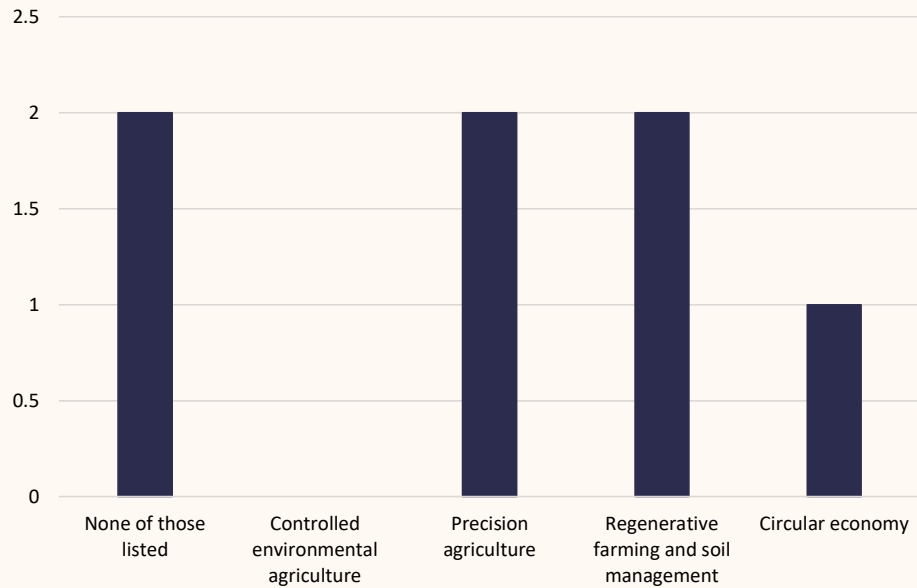


# 13.1 Farmer Survey

A survey was circulated via the Grow Yorkshire stakeholder newsletter, which questioned farmers current and future skills, particularly related to agri-tech. However, due to the limited responses, some caution must be taken with these findings and should not be generalised.



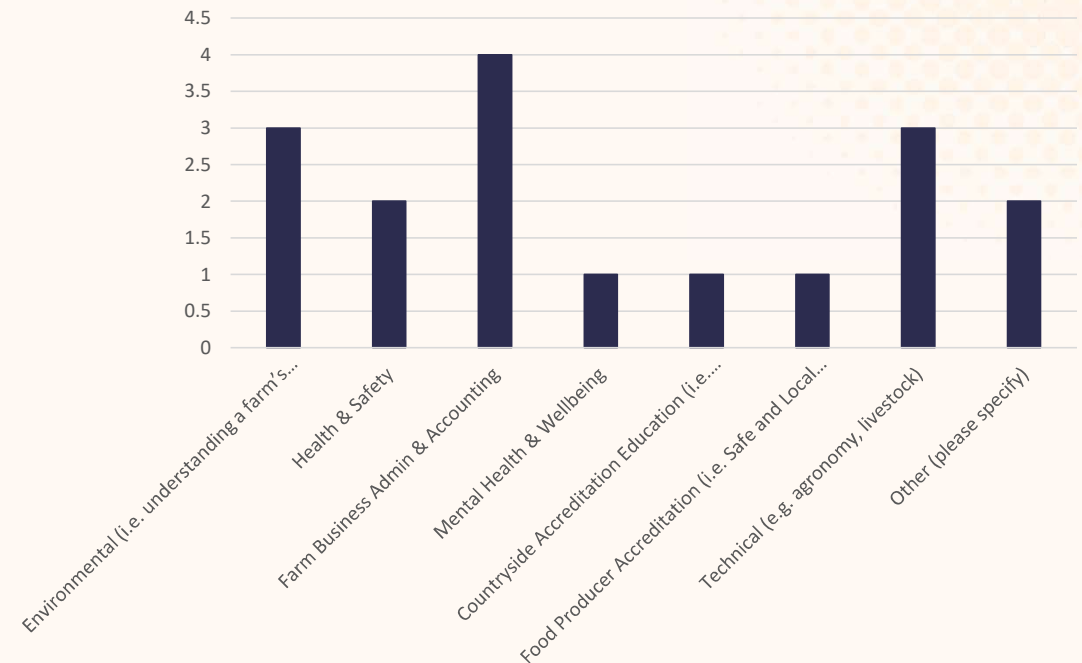
### Do you use any of these methods on your farm?



For those respondents not using these methods, this was due feeling their current system work fine, within this system they 'recycle manures and look after the soil and try different production techniques'. Some felt that this list was 'too prescriptive' and that 'farms aren't one or the others and it's almost impossible to label exactly'. It was also noted that there aren't defined and clear standards for examples such as regenerative farming, unlike organic farming.

Another suggested that these terms are sometimes used incorrectly and 'elements of farming are misunderstood'.

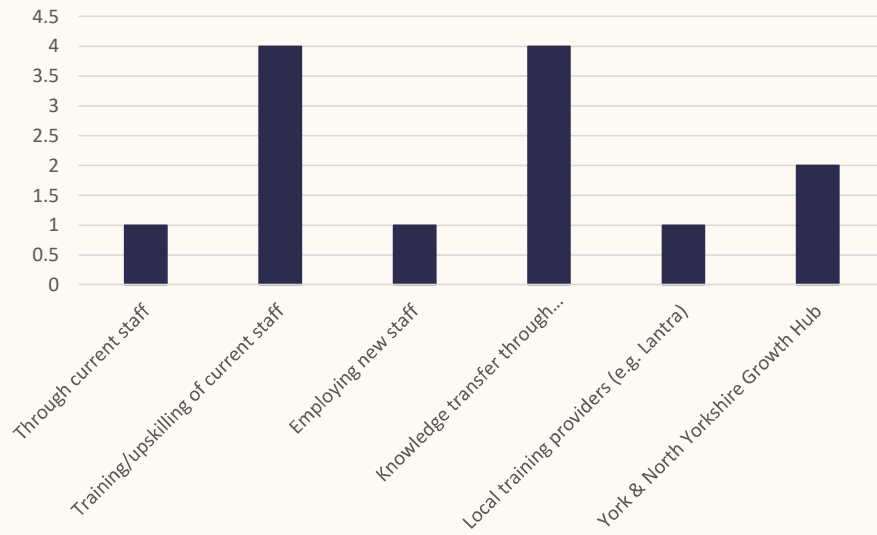
### What are the key skills that your business currently requires within these identified themes? (Tick all that apply)



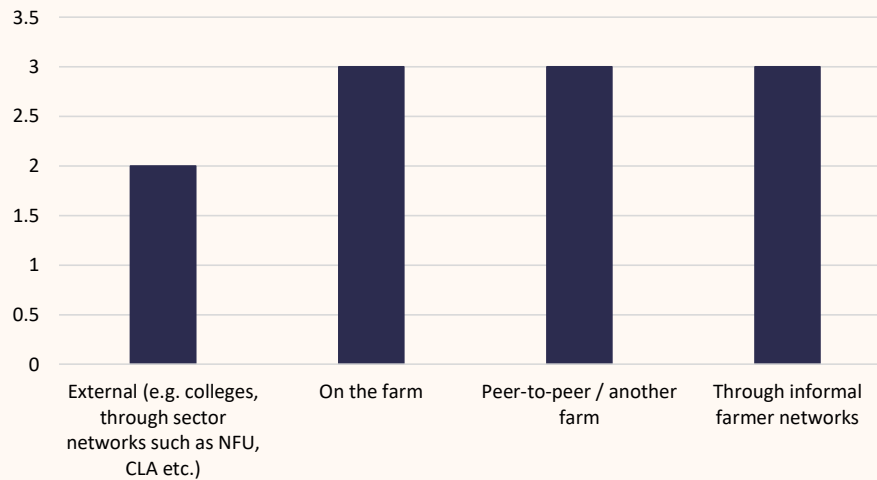

- 'Assessing best use of land'

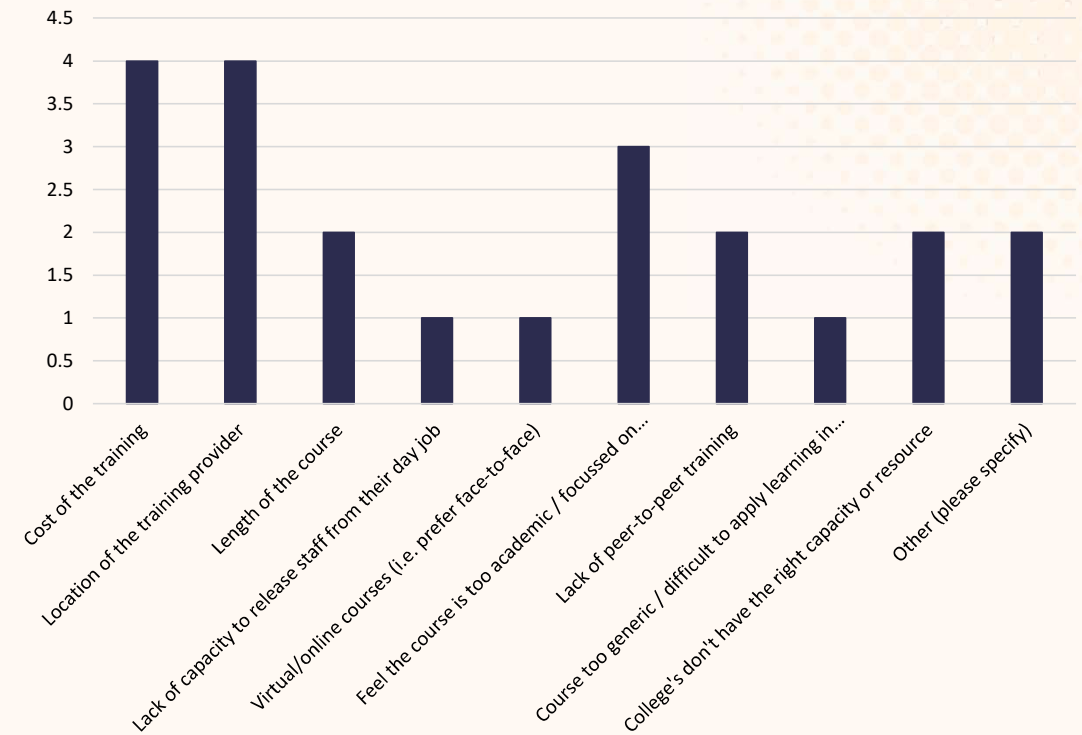
How are you looking to access these skills?



If you're looking to train current staff, where would you prefer the training is held?



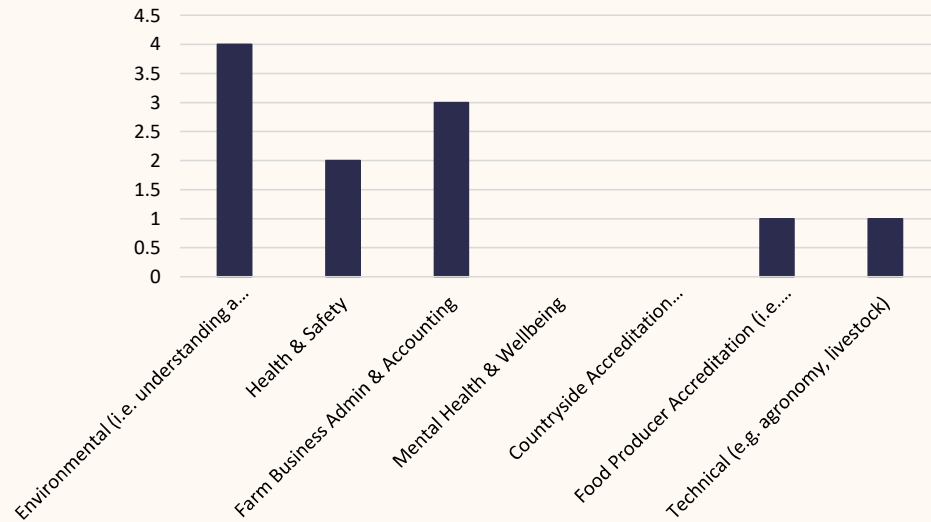
Do any of the following factors limit you from accessing external training support? (Tick all that apply)

- 'Lack of time. When there are so many daily jobs to be done it's hard to get off the farm'

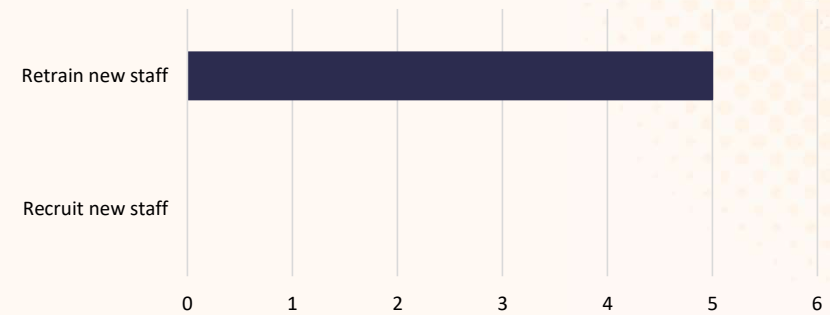
What are the future skills that your business requires? (Tick all that apply)



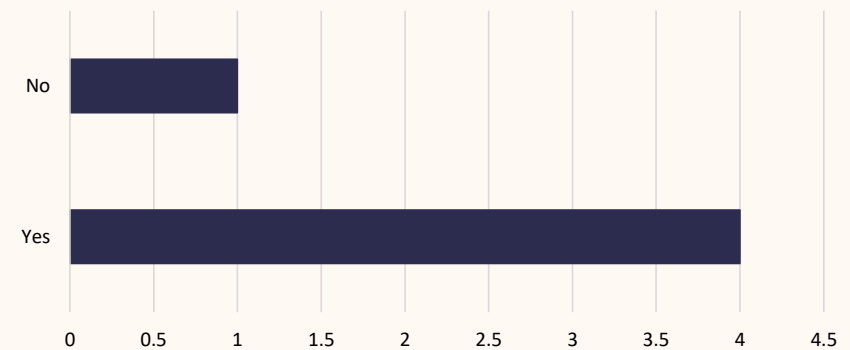
The biggest drivers for needing these skills included:

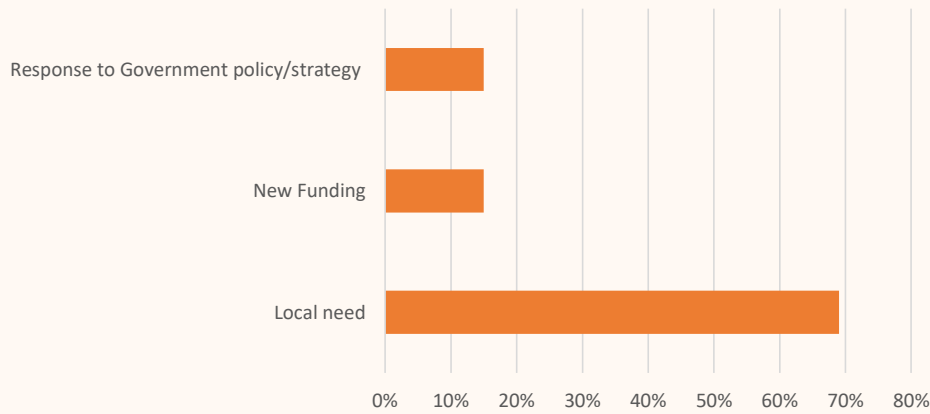

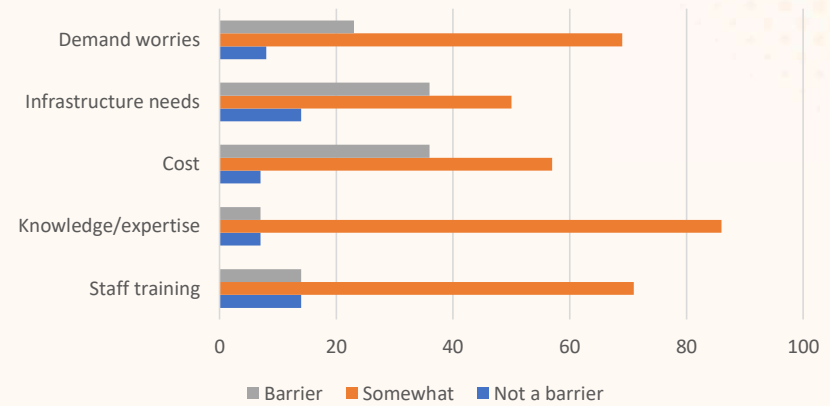

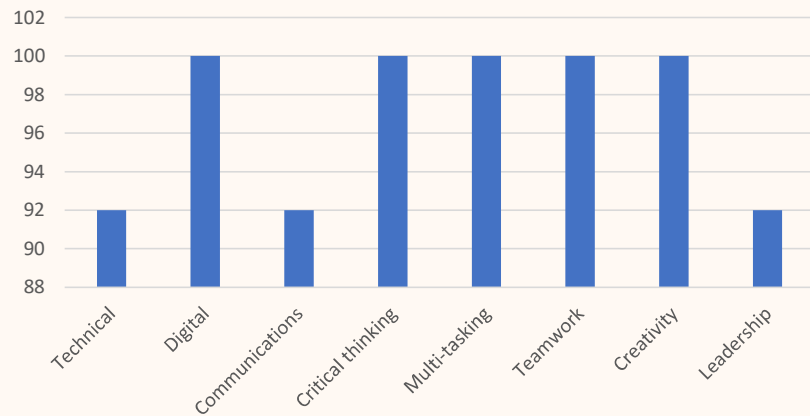
What is influencing future delivery plans? %



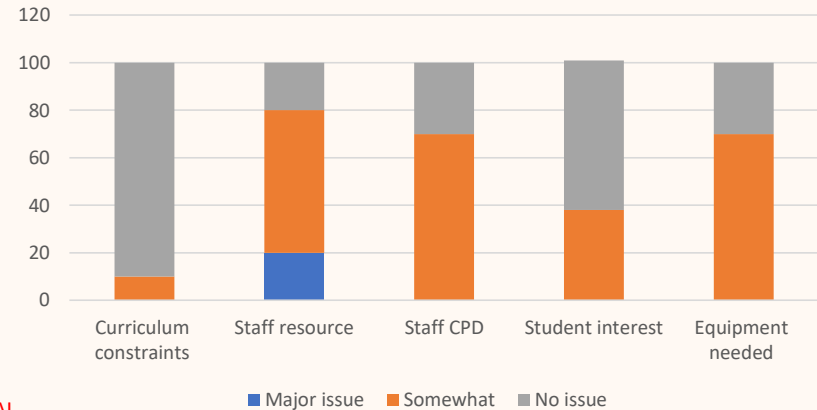
What are the barriers to future delivery? (%)
